Notes to Financials Results for the guarter ended June 30, 2025:

- The standalone and consolidated financial results of the company for the quarter ended June 30, 2025 have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their respective meetings held on August 7, 2025. The Statutory Auditors of the company have carried out a Limited review on these financial results.
- The above financial results have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles of accounting standards generally accepted in India, including the Indian Accounting Standards ("Ind AS") prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and in compliance with Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015.
- The figures of the quarter ended March 31, 2025 as reported in these financial results are the balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year ended March 31, 2025 and the unaudited published year-to-date figures upto the third quarter of the respective financial year. The figures upto the end of third quarter of previous financial year has only been reviewed and not subjected to audit.
- The standalone operations of the company falls primarily under manufacturing of garments which is considered to be the only reportable segment by the management. For consolidated operations, the Group has primarily four operating segments (Hongkong, Bangladesh, India and Vietnam), which have been determined and presented on geographical basis.
- 5 Other income of Rs. 2594.09 lakh in respect of standalone financial results for the guarter ended June 30, 2025, includes Dividend of Rs. 984.77 lakh and Rs. 854.63 Lakh received from foreign subsidiaries, Norp Knit Industries Limited and Pearl Global (HK) Limited respectively.
- The Board of Directors of the Company at its meeting held on May 20, 2025 had declared second interim dividend of Rs. 6.50/- per equity share having face value of Rs. 5/- each for the financial year 2024-25. Such Dividend has been paid during the guarter ended June 2025.
- 7 Exceptional items comprised loss on sale of Property, Plant & Equipment and Investment Property aggregating to Rs. 31.96 lakh (net) and Rs. 31.96 lakh (net) in respect of Standalone financial results and Consolidated financial results respectively for the quarter ended June 30, 2025.
- The Indian Parliament had approved the Code on Social Security, 2020. The Ministry of Labour and Employment has notified the draft rules under the Code on Social Security, 2020 on November 13, 2020 inviting objections and suggestions, if any, from the stakeholders. The draft rules provide for operationalization of provisions in the Code on Social Security, 2020 relating to Employees' Provident Fund, Employees' State Insurance Corporation, Gratuity, Maternity Benefit, Social Security and Cess in respect of Building and Other Construction Workers, Social Security for Unorganised Workers, Gig Workers and Platform Workers.
 - The Company will assess the impact and will give appropriate accounting treatment in its financial statements in the period in which the Code on Social Security, 2020 (including the related rules framed thereunder) becomes effective.
- Employee benefit expenses is provided for Rs. 123.02 Lakh in standalone financials and Rs. 144.02 lakh in consolidated financials against the stock options given to employees of the company/subsidiary company. During the quarter under review, 21050 shares were allotteed to the eligible employees of the company on exercise of stock options.
- During the quarter ended June 30, 2025, the Company through its Step-Down Subsidiary, DSSP Global Limited, Hong Kong, has acquired an additional 5% stake from the Minority Shareholder in PT Pinnacle Apparels, Post this acquisition, the Company through its Step-Down Subsidiary. DSSP Global Limited, Hong Kong is now holding 89,93% stake in PT Pinnacle Apparels.

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Independent Auditor's Review Report on Unaudited Quarterly Consolidated Financial Results of the Company Pursuant to the Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (as amended)

To The Board of Directors of Pearl Global Industries Limited

- 1. We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited consolidated financial results ("the Statement") of Pearl Global Industries Limited ("the Holding Company") and its subsidiaries (the Holding Company and its Subsidiaries together referred to as "the Group") for the quarter ended June 30, 2025, being submitted by the Holding Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("the Regulation"), including relevant circulars issued by SEBI from time to time ("the Circulars").
- 2. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Holding Company's Management and approved by the Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 (Ind AS 34) "Interim Financial Reporting", prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, as amended read with relevant rules issued thereunder, the Circulars and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the Statement based on our review.
- 3. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity", issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

We also performed procedures in accordance with the circular issued by the SEBI under Regulation 33 (8) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, to the extent applicable.

- 4. The Statement includes the results of the entities listed in Annexure A.
- 5. Based on our review conducted and procedures performed as stated in paragraph 3 above and based on the consideration of the review reports of the other auditors referred to in paragraph 6 & 7 below, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the aforesaid Indian Accounting Standard (Ind AS) prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 as amended, read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of the Regulation read with Circulars, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
- 6. We did not review the interim financial statements / financial results of four subsidiaries included in the consolidated unaudited financial results, whose interim financial statements reflects total revenues (before eliminating of inter-company transaction of ₹ 16,687.28 lakh) of ₹ 116,018.12 lakh, total net profit after tax (before eliminating of inter-company transaction of ₹ Nil) of ₹ 7,646.35 lakh and total comprehensive income (before eliminating of inter-company transaction of ₹ (0.02) lakh) of ₹ 6,557.23 lakh for the quarter ended June 30,2025 as considered in the consolidated unaudited financial results. These interim financial statements have been reviewed by other auditors whose reports have been furnished to us by the Management and our conclusion on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries, and our report in terms of regulation read with the Circulars, in so far as it relates to the aforesaid subsidiaries, are based on the reports of the other auditors and the procedures performed by us as stated in paragraph 3 above.

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Further, all of above mentioned subsidiaries are located outside India whose financial statements have been prepared in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in their respective countries and those have been reviewed by other auditors under International Standard on Review Engagement (ISRE) applicable in their respective countries. The Holding Company's Management has converted the financial statements of such subsidiaries from accounting principles generally accepted in their respective countries to accounting principles generally accepted in India. We have reviewed these conversion adjustments made by the Holding Company's management. Our conclusion, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries located outside India is based on the report of other auditors in their respective countries and conversion adjustments made by the Company's Management and reviewed by us.

- 7. The Statement also include the interim financial statements/ financial results of two foreign subsidiaries and three domestic subsidiaries, included in the consolidated unaudited financial results, whose interim financial statements reflect total revenues (before eliminating of inter-company transaction of ₹ 742.30 lakh) of ₹ 1,456.64 lakh, total net profit after tax (before eliminating of inter-company transaction of Nil) of ₹ (1,835.36) lakh and total comprehensive income (before eliminating of inter-company transaction of Nil) of ₹ (1832.38) lakh for the quarter ended June 30, 2025 as considered in the consolidated unaudited financial results, which have not been reviewed by us. These financial statements / financial results are un-reviewed and have been certified by the respective Management and furnished to us by Holding Company's Management. Our conclusion, in so far as it relates to the amounts included in respect of aforesaid subsidiaries, is based solely on such interim financial statements/ financial results. In our view and according to the information and explanations given to us by the Holding Company's Management, these interim financial statements/ financial results are not material to the Group.
- 8. Our conclusion on the Statement in respect of matters stated in para 6 and 7 above is not modified with respect to our reliance on the work done & the reports of other auditors, conversion adjustments made by the Company's Management and the financial statements/ financial results, as certified by the respective management.
- 9. Attention is drawn to the fact that the figures for the three months ended March 31, 2025 as reported in these unaudited consolidated financial results are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of the full previous financial year and the published year to date figures upto the third quarter of the previous financial year. The figures upto the end of the third quarter of previous financial year had only been reviewed and not subject to audit. Our conclusion is not modified in respect of this matter.
